



Jury

The jury is composed of the IIBA Geneva chapter board, who can enlist recognized persons coming from universities, IIBA members, private and public Swiss as well as other persons.

Whenever a member of the jury is in possible conflict of interest, she/he must withdraw from the jury.

Submission of applications

The submitted projects must have taken place during 2018 and, if possible, completed.

The applications must be submitted latest on Friday February 22, 2019.

A service provider having realized a project for a customer can be responsible for the submission only if the company owning the project agrees.

Price

The winner will be offered

- 1 article on the winning project in a professional journal
- to present its project at an IIBA Geneva Chapter workshop
- a trophy

Winner selection process

Each project shall present a request by completing the application form.

The Jury will select the finalists.

The winner will be announced at the IIBA Geneva Conference, which will take place in Lausanne on March 21, 2019. A representative of each finalist team will be invited for that purpose at the conference.

Confidentiality

The *Swiss* BA Award competition is realized with full confidentiality. The documents and information will be returned to each participants after the award ceremony. IIBA Geneva will keep no documents without the prior approval of the company owning the project.

Consent

The candidates to the competition commit to provide information relative to their nomination in good faith. They also commit that the name of the winning project and the finalists will be published in various media and publications.

Annulation

IIBA Geneva reserves the right to cancel the competition if the number of applications would be insufficient.

Final Dispositions.

In case of an issue, the French version of this regulation is the reference.

Any recourse to the legal way is excluded.
